



APICULTURE TRAINING





TCT DALMANN APICULTURE TRAINING COURSE

The TCT Dalmann bee keeping training facility opened in 2010 and was upgraded in 2012. The training course is conducted over a period of 5 days in 2 separate phases:

Phase 1 is conducted at Catapu, the TCT concession and sawmill and this phase is three days long. Phase 2 is at the location of the final destination of the hives. This phase is two days long.



Phase 1 : Catapu

- The introduction to bee keeping
- Bee keeping
- Risks to bees
- Environmental concerns
- Safety and security
- Preparation and construction of hives
- Repair and maintenance of hives
- In field siting, preparation and mounting
- The use of personal protective clothing and auxiliary equipment
- Handling of live bees
- Fire management and prevention

Phase 2 : On location

- Hive siting and site preparation
- Mounting of the hives
- Fire prevention training
- Honey cropping
- Post crop monitoring and management



Hands on training

All training is focused on practical “hands on” and in the field training. Participants are not just shown the process and items, but actually get involved in physical aspects of bee keeping from making hives , working in the field, extracting honey etc.

Training Manual

The 26 page training manual has been designed and produced by TCT for the purpose of this course and as a guide for referral after training.

Bee Hives

TCT Dalmann sell Kenyan top bar hives for Mt1,860.00 including IVA.

(This price excludes transportation from Catapu). We supply complete hives that can be put into production immediately.

Participants do not have to purchase hives but it is recommended that a minimum of 5 hives are purchased per participant. Hives can also be purchased independently.

- Safety equipment (bee suits) and auxiliary equipment for infield training (the participants will require their own bee suits and smokers etc. by the time their hives start producing)
